<b>Description on Calvert LSA</b>	(One [1], four-year scholarship at \$500/year; renewable) Eligible applicant must be a 2017 graduate from a Calvert County or St. Mary's County public or private high school who has maintained at least a 3.00 GPA (85% cumulative percentage grade point). The applicant must plan to pursue a college degree with the goal of becoming a teacher. Separate essay is required, in addition to the 2017 CLSA Student Essay/Personal Statement.
