| Description on Calvert LSA | <p>(One to six [1-6], \$2,000 (\$500/year) renewable with SAP of 3.0 or better in college. The eligible applicant will embody the spirit and community awareness of Eric and Cara Thorn. To keep alive the memory of what outstanding students and compassionate people Eric and Cara Thorn were, a scholarship fund was established to benefit students from CCPS public high schools.
